## Ordinance Review, Replacement, and Repeal

FEMA develops new flood maps which require municipalities to adopt in March. This suggested ordinance was created to help communities meet the Nebraska Minimum Standards for Floodplain Management Programs and the requirements in Title 44 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter 1, Part 60.3 (d) as part of the National Flood Insurance Program.
